



How to Install... for Corrugated Roof

D.I.Y. Gutter Guard

How to Measure Your Gutter



Step 1: Measure the length of the guttering. Add 5-10% for overlap and wastage.

Step 2: Decide what colour you will need (important for steel roofs as it will be seen).

Step 3: Go to Special Orders desk at your local Bunnings. Ask for **Gumleaf DIY Gutter Guard**. Tell them the **number of metres**, the **Fold** (if your roof is tile) and the **colour** needed.

You're done!



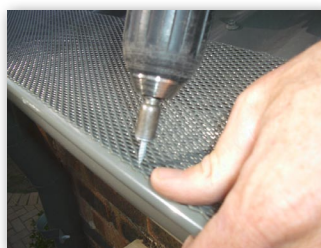
Step 1

Clean out gutters and flush downpipes.



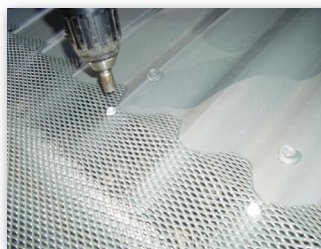
Step 2

Fold scallops of gutter guard down about 30 degrees with thumb and forefinger. Lay in place so that scallop fits nicely in corrugation on roof.



Step 3

Secure to the lip of guttering with self-tapping screws, approximately 300mm apart.



Step 4

Along scalloped edge, place screws on every 2nd corrugation rise aligned with the existing roof screws.



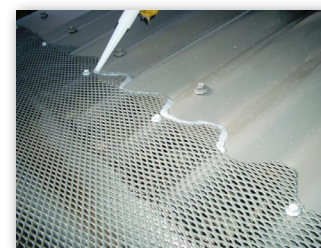
Step 5

Interlock each piece of gutter guard where they overlap.



Step 6

Run guard over hip and cut and screw to fit as neat as possible.



Step 7

Apply thin bead of silicone along scalloped edge of gutter protection to eliminate small gap.



Then stand back and admire your great work!
