



How to Measure Your Gutter



Step 1: Measure the length of the guttering. Add 5-10% for overlap and wastage.

Step 2: Decide what colour you will need.

Step 3: Measure the gap between gutter lip and edge of tiles (this is classed as the Fold). i.e. 70-100mm.
IMPORTANT: Make sure the bottom row of tiles can be slid back (no cyclone clips or nails)

Step 4: Go to Special Orders desk at your local Bunnings. Ask for **Gumleaf DIY Gutter Guard**. Tell them the **number of metres**, the Fold (if your roof is tile) and the **colour** needed.

You're done!

How to Install... for Tiled Roof




Step 1

Clean out gutters and flush downpipes.



Step 2

Slide first row of tiles back.




Step 3

Place screws into gutter lip about 300mm apart.



Step 4

Overlap guard approximately 10mm.



Step 5

Interlock guard in middle of both pieces.

D.I.Y. Gutter Guard



Step 6

Slide tiles back to original position.



Step 7

Cut desired length of corner.



Step 8

Fold down back piece to make a double fold.



Step 9

Piece should fit comfortably into corner.



Step 10

Cut and screw neatly to fit.
